

### PALSD 2023 SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

The Pan Asian Lawyers of San Diego will grant four scholarships<sup>1</sup> to eligible individuals to assist in covering the cost of the California State Bar Exam.

## Eligible individuals must:

- 1) Be a current 3L student or recent graduate from any accredited law school in San Diego County; and
- 2) personally attend the PALSD's Annual Dinner on May 31, 2023, to receive the scholarship

#### **Selection factors** include but are not limited to:

- financial need
- academic achievement, work experience, and extracurricular activities;
- past, current, and future public service to the Asian/Pacific Islander community and other diverse communities as a heavily weighed factor;
- post law school goals;
- domicile (residence plus intent to remain) in San Diego as a plus;
- interview (by phone or in person) at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee

• APPLICATIONS AND ANY SUPPORTING MATERIALS MUST BE RECEIVED BY Friday, April 21, 2023, at 11:59 p.m.

- Applications postmarked on April 21, 2023 will be considered late—they must be **received** by April 21, 2023.
- Any application which is supplemented by supporting materials submitted after the deadline will be considered late.
- The application and any supplemental materials must be submitted in ONE package.
- (NO EXTENSIONS WILL BE GRANTED.)
